

Chaminade HS students may participate in ACC courses if they meet the following academic standards:

**MBU ECP Policy:**

Juniors and Seniors must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% are automatically eligible for dual credit courses.

Juniors and Seniors with an overall cumulative grade point average between 75% - 80% must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal or guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Sophomores must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% and must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Freshmen must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% and score at the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile or above on the ACT or SAT, and provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

**SLU 1818 ACC Policy:**

Juniors and seniors must have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and electronic approval of the 1818 course instructor or 1818 Partner Coordinator

Sophomores are eligible to enroll in 1818 courses in certain circumstances, to include sequenced 1818 courses in Language courses numbered 1010 or above. Sophomores may be approved by

by 1818 Partners to enroll if the students have

-a minimum 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and

-completed the pre-requisite course/s with a grade/s of "B" or higher or

-provide a signed letter of recommendation from the principal and guidance counselor attesting to the student's suitability to take this course for college credit, and

-provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian and electronic approval of the 1818 class instructor or 1818 Partner Coordinator

Freshmen are not eligible to enroll in 1818 courses.

**UMSL ACP Policy:**

Juniors and Seniors must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% are automatically eligible for dual credit courses.

Juniors and Seniors with an overall cumulative grade point average between 75% - 79% must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal or guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Sophomores must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% and must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Freshmen must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80%, and score at the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile or above on the ACT, SAT, or a comparable nationally standardized assessment, and provide a signed statement of support from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.
