



Junior-Senior Prom

May 4, 2019

This flyer contains all of the information regarding this year's Junior-Senior Prom. **Please be certain to read through this carefully so that there are no misunderstandings.**

Place: The Ely Walker (ground floor)
1520 Washington Ave.

Parking: We have contracted for parking with a gated, fenced and guarded parking lot on [16th street between Lucas and Delmar Blvd](#). This lot is directly across from City Museum's main entrance. An attendant will be on duty. Tell the attendant is that you're with Chaminade's prom, and they'll let you in. There is no extra money needed for use of this parking lot. Parking in this lot requires a walk of about 400 feet (same distance from the Atrium to the Skip).

Time: 7:30-11:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 4th

- All couples **MUST** arrive by 8:30 p.m.
- **ALL couples must remain at prom until the coronation of the prom court at 10:30.**
- Any exceptions to the arrival and departure times above must be approved in advance.

Cost: \$150 *per couple* in the form of cash or check (payable to Chaminade) in the Spirit Store during normal Spirit Store hours or by credit card online ([link](#)¹).

VERY IMPORTANT: ALL PAYMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 3:15 p.m. (Spirit Store) or 9:00 p.m. (online) on Tuesday, APRIL 30th.

Payment for prom includes admission to prom, parking, tank tops for students and their dates, live photo booth, dinner, deserts and soft drinks. Anything you might do in addition to this before or after the event is up to you.

Catering:² Red Oak Catering will provide dinner and desert. Menu: build-your-own taco bar (ground beef, pulled chicken, jackfruit, + toppings); build-your-own French fry bar; nugget bar (from Fried); hand food bar (chips, veggies, bread, dips); and a slider bar (BBQ chicken, pig-in-a-biscuit, jackfruit; from Red Oak Biscuits); milk & cookie bar (4 kinds of cookies; 4 kinds of milks); soda, coffee, tea, juices.

Music: CJ's DJ's will provide the evening's music.

Tank Tops: All who attend receive a souvenir tank top. If you are going to prom, we need to know what size tank you'd like for yourself **and for your date**. We will need to order shirts next week, so we would appreciate your prompt attention to this.

Everyone who attends will get a tank top. Students who provide the information asked for above will be assured of getting what they want.

Photo Booth: Photographers will be at prom to take photo booth pictures of couples and other groups. Photos are printed on site. There is no additional cost for these photos.

Prom Court: All students who attend prom are eligible for the Prom Court. The Prom Court will be announced at Prom at 10:30 p.m.

Security: Two uniformed St. Louis police officers will be present in the areas of the prom venue and the parking lot for the duration of the event. The prom venue also has its own private security. Students should **not** leave valuables inside their cars, and other items (coats, backpacks, etc.) should be kept out of sight. Please be sure to lock your car.

¹ Please be advised that there is a \$5 service charge for this online transaction. You can avoid this fee by bringing a check or cash to the Spirit Store during normal store hours.

² Per the caterer, there are no peanuts or tree nuts in any of the food. Students who rely on epi-pens due to food allergies should be sure to have them regardless.

Other Recommendations:

- Be certain that a name and phone number is contained in everything you and your date bring to prom – camera cases, tuxedo jackets, purses, etc. – so that these items can be returned to you in case you lose them.
- If you have arranged to drop-off/pick-up with a limousine, party bus, or some other driver, make certain that your driver knows when to pick you up to go to prom and when you wish him/her to return to take you home. A drop-off/pick-up zone is directly in front of the venue's entrance on Washington.
- Be certain to bring everything you will need for the evening from your car when you arrive. Once you're in, you will not be allowed to go out to your car to retrieve anything without adult supervision.
- This is a formal event, and it is expected that you will conduct yourselves in a manner appropriate to the occasion. This includes your attire. Formal dress for men means a tuxedo or suit. It is more difficult to give specific guidelines for women, and we don't have any specific rules requiring or banning anything they might wear. Having said that, your dates should consider matters of both taste (appropriate for junior and senior students at a Catholic school) and comfort. Many style guides suggest that women consider wearing longer dresses or cocktail-length dresses.

Since this is a school function, all school rules are in full effect, including rules about smoking, drinking and the use of illegal drugs. Please be sure that you and your date observe these rules in order to ensure a safe and trouble-free evening for all. All in attendance may be asked to take a breath alcohol detection test before entry or at any time during the event.
